This practical workshop explores the dynamics inherent in groups and introduces a range of creative modalities which can be effectively deployed to democratize insight.

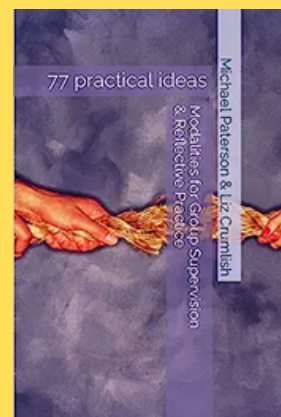
## *Eligibility*
